Ornamentation and Chords

Here are some grace notes or 'crushed' notes. They are a quick note that you play just before the main note of the tune. They are very common in Scottish traditional music and they are written out below as you would see them on the music. Have a go at playing some and you can add them into the tune Father John MacMillan of Barra.



Here are some new chords - F# minor and B minor.
Minor chords had a 'sad' sound to them instead of a happy sound.
Try moving between the two chords.
